The 8th World Day of the Poor will be celebrated on
Sunday, November 17, 2024. The theme for this year
is "The prayer of the poor rises up to God," which
comes from the Book of Sirach (Sir 21:5).

Pope Francis established the World Day of the Poor in
2017. In his message for the 2024 event, he invites
people to pray for the poor with humility and trust,
and to remember that the poor are held in a special
place in God's heart. He also notes that the violence
caused by wars and misguided policies impoverishes
many people, and that each person has the image of
the Son of God.

The World Day of the Poor is an opportunity to
remember and thank the people who support the
poor, and to give more serious spiritual attention to
them.
