Many events across the United States take place on **Armed Forces Day** (May 21, 2022) to honor Americans in uniform who served their country in times of war and peace. Those who are honored on this day include people who serve the Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force and Coast Guard. National Guard and Reserve units may celebrate Armed Forces Day/Week over any period in May because of their unique training schedules.

Certain types of music are also played at Armed Forces Day events, including at memorials and at cemeteries, as a way to respect those in the armed forces who died for their country. For example, buglers have played a bugle call, known simply as *Taps*, on Armed Forces Day in recent years. *Taps* is usually sounded by the United States military at events such as flag ceremonies, memorial services and funerals.
